ICT Training

During our first executive meeting early January, 2020 at Elmina, we all were tasked to involve all schools in komenda into the ICT project which wasn't an easy task though but because our overall aim is to provide educational services, especially to support young people in rural areas.

By doing so, we had several meetings with almost all school head teachers in komenda on how best we can achieve the above aim, since we are not supposed to teach the same students during school hours.

Fortunate for us, we were able to organize some ICT classes within January, February and March, 2020.

There were a lot of challenges from the beginning with the total number of students per class as comparing to the number of computers at the training centre so we had to group the students per our computers.

It wasn't easy with the teaching because we had to repeat the same topic for five to six times just for only class, so can imagine having two or three class in a day. Things became very tough after March, 2020 where there was a total lock down because of COVID19 Pandemic.

After some months, we were able to organize other classes with different schools, where students were given nose masks, liquid soaps and running water for hand wash and others just to follow the protocols given by the Ghana Government.


The students were given the opportunity to explore the computer user interface, learn professional handling of application software like Microsoft Office and how to move responsibly and targeted in the web.

AIM played active part in educating the public on the need to wear nose mask and follow the Covid 19 protocols as enunciated by the state. This was a major voluntary work that we embarked.


NABCO ISSUES


SOLAR WORKSHOP
